





NOTICE OF RACE Open Dutch Championship of the Solo class

organised by WV Braassemermeer under the auspices of the RNWA from 22 to 24 September 2023 location: Braassemermeer, Roelofarendsveen

The notation '[NP]'in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*. The prescriptions of the RNWA can be found at http://www.sailing.org/documents/racingrules/national prescriptions.php.
- 1.2 The 'Rules for (Open) Championships Sailing, Windsurfing and Kiteboarding' will apply.

- 1.6 Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Solo class.
- 4.2 To be considered an entry in this regatta eligible boats shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

5 FEES

- 5.1 The required fee for this championship is € 65,-.(this is including happy hour on 22 September). If the registration and payment are received before the 7th of September 2023 at 23h59 (early bird). After this date the required fee will be € 80,-.

- 5.3 On Saturday 23 September there will be a Captains Diner for € 25,- per person. Registration and payment for this diner is asked before the 20th of September via the event page at: http://soloklasse.nl/evenement/open-dutch-championship, together with the required fee.

8 QUALIFYING SERIES AND FINAL SERIES

- 8.1 When on the closing day more than 60 boats have entered, the event will consist of a qualifying and a final series.

9.6 On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 15:00.

10 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

13 THE COURSES

The course will be an upwind – downwind course, with a gate downwind and a gate upwind. (A)

If the wind is rather strong the race committee may decide to change the course in a trianglecourse. (B)

15 SCORING

- 15.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.
- 15.2 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When 5,6,7 or 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - (c) When 9 or 10, races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

Support boats may be marked with RC.

21 DATA PROTECTION

21.1 By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

22 RISK STATEMENT

- 22.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- 22.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

23 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 or the equivalent per incident.

24 PRIZES

The RNWA supplies for the winning boat a blue pennant and a medal for every helmsman of the first three boats.

Other prizes may be given.




- Campers: On site, € 12,50 per night please contact the Harbour Master (06 10238295) to book your place, as places are limited.
